## **Water Printing on Cloth - Material List**

## Students are responsible for bringing

- 1. A **sturdy** clear plastic storage bin with a **lid** that will be used as individual printing bath and to carry leftover printing solution and dye ready paints home. These can be purchased from hardware/craft stores. For 12"x12" or 12" x 20" throw pillows purchase a 23" x 16"x 7" between "\$8-15" (Note: the size of the plastic bin dictates the size of your pillow!)
- 2. A generous stack of newspapers for skimming (not the glossy colored advertisements pages)
- 3. Optional: Purchase their own fabric. A combination of white, neutral or pale solid colored poplin, cotton, cotton/linen, velvet or silk. Approx. 2 to 3 yards There will also be some scrap fabric available to play with!
- 4. Optional: Mordant will be available in the class. Pre-mordant with alum the fabric. Alum can be bought at local Amish grocery stores.
  NOTE: The instructor will be in touch about instructions for fabric and mordant when we have enough students to fill the class.
- 5. Some kind of apron or cover up to protect clothing
