

Draw with Pen and Ink with Watercolor Washes

Drawing and painting are intertwined, mark making and texture expand our artistic vocabulary. Working from still-life and photographs we will practice line drawing with added watercolor to enhance the drawings. We will also work with ink brushes to develop painterly expression in drawings.

Materials

Drawing Pens: 01, 03, 05

Suggested:

Sakura Micropen Derwent

Uni Pin Staedtler

(I have found Sakura Micropen the least likely to bleed)

Drawing Pad: 90 lb (250 gsm) 9x12 (e.g., Legion Stonehenge at BLICK)

OR Watercolor sketchbook

Watercolors or colored inks

Round watercolor brushes or calligraphy brushes

If you have paper or sketchbooks that you would like to use, test it for its ability to take water. Surface texture will affect the ability to make marks. Smooth will be best.

Watercolor sketchbooks: cold or hot press

Small containers of black drawing ink any brand
