



A Morning of Plein Air Painting!

- ☑ Sketchbooks or watercolor pads
- ☑ A basic watercolor selection brushes and palette or Water-soluble pencils and a brush
- ☑ Water bottle for you and your paints
- ☑ A container for rinsing your brushes
- ☑ Rags or paper towels
- ☑ A hat and sunscreen
- ☑ A folding chair or stool
